

## **Lens Room Operator**

**Location:** Bradenton, Florida, USA

**Reports To:** Team Leader

### **Job Summary**

Following established methods and procedures, applies anti-fog coatings to glass lenses and ensures there are no visible defects.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Uses appropriate equipment, or manually applies special anti-fog coating to glass lenses to support production demands.
- Follows and meets customer demand schedule and recommends improvements to meet efficiencies.
- Understands and follow work orders, drawings, verbal instructions and procedures including start-up and shut down procedures, anti-fog pre-cleaning procedures, primer mixing instructions, anti-fog primer and coating applications, glass lens excess anti-fog coating removal, and anti-fog coating curing temperature and timing procedures.
- Maintains constant visual inspection to ensure product meets quality standards.
- Identifies defects and takes appropriate corrective action to reduce scrap. Includes scratches, wrinkles, bubbles, and entrapped particles on lens, before and after coating.
- Runs first piece inspection and verifies conformity to specifications and standards.
- Proper handling and operation of the equipment and materials: scales, stirring machine, filters, beakers, ovens, timers, scraper, hoses, suction cups, lens trays, labels, and razor blades.
- Observes all safety, security, and personal protection requirements.
- Maintains equipment and replaces filters as prescribed.
- Keeps work area clean to the standards required for operation of the lens room. (5S)
- Detects and reports defective materials, mechanical failures, or questionable conditions to supervisor.
- Maintains accurate written logs, inventories, and other records.
- Performs other duties and assignments as may be assigned. Expected to be available to work in other areas of production and must be able to work overtime when required (including short notice overtime) to meet daily customer demands.

### **Education and Experience**

High School diploma or General Education Degree (GED); one to three months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience

### **Qualifications**

- Ability to read, comprehend and follow instructions and diagrams.
- Ability to speak and write clearly in English and effectively exchange information.
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide using whole numbers.
- Ability to operate and understand scale readings in weight from grams to pounds.

**Other Knowledge, Skills and Abilities**

- Follows instructions and meets productivity standards.
- Able to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Adapts to changes in the work environment and uses time effectively.
- Pays attention to detail and checks own work to ensure quality.
- Responds promptly to customer needs (internal and external).
- Treats others with respect and consideration and supports company goals and objectives.
- Puts success of team above own interests.
- Above average attendance

**Physical Demands**

This position requires the employee to stand for long periods of time (up to 8 hours) and walk. Employee is regularly required to use hands and fingers, reach with hands and arms, and talk and hear. Employee is frequently required to balance, bend, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl and regularly lift or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.

**Work Environment**

This position is in a manufacturing plant in a climate-controlled area. Employee may be exposed to moving mechanical parts, fumes and chemicals. Employee must observe personal protection procedures.
